

**STUDENT INFORMATION SHEET**  
**--SPRING '17 SAT/ACT WORKSHOP--**

**WHAT?** Students will practice for the new SAT as well as for the ACT. There are seven 2.5 hour classes beginning March 5 and ending April 30. There are no classes during spring break.

**WHO?** High-school juniors who plan to take the SAT and/or ACT this spring.

**WHERE?** St Lawrence-Lewis BOCES Educational Services Center, 40 West Main St, Canton

**WHEN?** These Sundays:

March 5 (RW); 12 (M), 19 (RW), 26 (M); April 2 (Essay), 9 (M), and 30 (RW).

Note that no classes have been scheduled for April 16 and April 23 (unless needed for snow day makeup).

Students can register for one of the following class sessions:

**Section #1:** Sunday, 11 AM – 1:30 PM

**Section #2:** Sunday, 1:30 PM – 4 PM

**Section #3:** Sunday, 4 PM – 6:30 PM (offered depending on enrollment)

**Sections are assigned as registration forms are received. Register early to get your first choice.**

**DEADLINE?** Students must register with their guidance counselors before February 10. Contact Meg Clemens directly about late registrations.

**INSTRUCTORS?** Reading and Writing will be taught by David Dufrane and Math will be taught by Meg Clemens.

**COST?** \$140.00 per student. Some districts participate in the BOCES CoSer and the \$140.00 cost for their students may be all or partially paid by the district. Ask your guidance counselor.

**Canton, Clifton-Fine, Edwards-Knox, Gouverneur, Hermon-DeKalb, Heuvelton, Madrid-Waddington, and Salmon River** students must contact their guidance counselor to register. These schools are participating in the BOCES CoSer and the \$140.00 cost for their students may be all or partially paid by the district. Guidance counselors should mail or fax (386-4614) registration forms to Meg Clemens by February 10<sup>th</sup>. **Sections are assigned as registration forms are received.** Registration confirmations will be emailed to guidance counselors by February 13<sup>th</sup>. No cancellations allowed.

Students whose schools are not participating in the BOCES CoSer can enroll on a private basis by mailing to Meg Clemens (99 State Street, Canton, NY 13617) the registration form **and** a check for \$140.00 made payable to David Dufrane. Registration confirmations will be emailed to guidance counselors by February 13<sup>th</sup>. Home-school students will be telephoned or emailed.

**WHAT SHOULD STUDENTS BRING TO CLASS?**

1. SAT and ACT registration booklets, get from guidance office
2. Pen, pencil, colored highlighters, lined paper, and a pocket folder.
3. Graphing calculator for math classes (second class).
