WHAT? Students will practice for the SAT as well as for the ACT. There are seven 2.5-hour classes beginning March 5 or 6 and ending April 30 or May 1.

WHO? High-school juniors who plan to take the SAT and/or ACT this spring.

WHERE? Classes taught remotely using Google Classroom and Zoom.

WHEN? These Saturday or Sundays: March 5/6 (Math -M); 12/13 (Reading/Writing -RW), 19/20 (M), 26/27 (RW), April 2/3 (M); 9/10 (RW), and April 30/May 1 (RW). No classes are scheduled during spring break (April 16/17 and 23/24).

The following class times are offered. Final section assignments will be determined after the deadline.

Section #1: **Saturday**, 11 AM to 1:30 PM Section #2: **Saturday**, 1:30 PM to 4 PM Section #3: **Sunday**, 11 AM to 1:30 PM Section #4: **Sunday**, 1:30 PM to 4 PM

Sections are assigned as registration forms are received. Register early to get your first choice.

HOW TO REGISTER? Students at Canton, Colton-Pierrepont, Edwards-Knox, Gouverneur, Hammond, Hermon-DeKalb, Heuvelton, Lisbon, Madrid-Waddington, Morristown, Norwood-Norfolk, Ogdensburg, and Potsdam must register through their guidance counselor by February 16. These schools are participating in the SLL BOCES CoSer and the \$180.00 cost for their students may be all or partially paid by the district.
